GENERAL INFORMATION

- Name:** Lexington OktoberFest DooDah Parade
Date: October 22, 2011
Time: 11:00 a.m.
Place: Parade forms down Butler Street starting at Haygood Street. **NO LATER THAN 10:30 A.M.**
Route: From Butler Street left on Haygood Street, left on Main Street, then left on Northlake Drive and back to parade start (Butler Street).
Entry Fee: Must accompany application. Make checks payable to **Lake Murray Lions.**

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Serious entries are permitted, but not encouraged.
2. Minimum team size is one half (1/2) member. Maximum team size is 5,000 members.
3. Team members must be employees or members of the company or organization they represent. In the case of small companies or organizations, team members may recruit additional team members from the general population.
4. No drinkin' or cussin' allowed before, during or after the parade.
5. No Throwing of candy or other object permitted.
6. Teams are responsible for remembering to march in the numeric order they are assigned. Those who cannot count will be disqualified.
7. Bribery of parade judges is expressly forbidden. However, parade organizers will gratefully accept gratuities.
8. In case of a tie in the judging, the decision of the parade organizers is final (see item 8 for details.)
9. Parade entry fee for advance registration will be \$20.00 by October 7, 2011.
10. All entries must keep moving during the parade! No stopping will be allowed.
